



• Super Rush Processing (4-6 working days): For those moments when time is of the essence—immediate processing at the highest fee.

Q: Can I work in Bahrain with an eVisa?

A: Not quite—working requires a separate work permit.

Q: What if my eVisa is denied?

A: Don't panic! Reach out to Bahraini authorities for guidance and next steps.

Q: Do GCC residents need a visa for short stays?

A: No visa is needed, but you must have a valid national ID and a passport that meets entry requirements.
